**ITEM 1603-07: Approving an Amendment to the FY 2016-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Adding Washington Avenue (CR 608) Resurfacing in Atlantic County**

### **PROPOSAL**

At its March 14, 2016 meeting, the Technical Advisory Committee recommended that the Policy Board approve two amendments, one to add a project and one to delete a project from the FY 2016-2025 TIP.

### **PROJECTS**

**DB# S1410 – Eleventh Avenue (CR 669), Municipal Border to Route 50 (Broad Street), Mill & Overlay Resurfacing;** Atlantic County is requesting that this project be deleted from the FY 2016-2025 TIP/STIP. The project was funded for construction in FY 2017 for \$1,700,000.

**DB# S1603 – Washington Avenue (CR 608), Route 9 (New Road) to Fire Road (CR 651), Mill & Overlay Resurfacing;** Atlantic County is requesting that this project be added to the FY 2016-2025 TIP/STIP in FY 2017 \$1,700,000 for construction funding.

### **BACKGROUND**

Atlantic County is replacing the Eleventh Avenue project with the Washington Avenue project because the Washington Avenue project is in greater need of repair.

The switching of these two projects will not have a negative impact on the air quality in the region.

Fiscal constraint will be maintained as the funding for the new project is the same amount as the funding for the old project.

**RESOLUTION 1603-07: Approving an Amendment to the FY 2016-2025 Transportation Improvement Program Adding Washington Avenue (CR 608) Resurfacing in Atlantic County**

**WHEREAS, the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization (SJTPO) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) designated under federal law for the southern region of New Jersey including Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland, and Salem Counties; and**

**WHEREAS, MPO's are responsible for developing a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that sets forth the capital expenditures for at least four years, as required by the Federal Metropolitan Planning Rule (23 CFR 450C and 49 CFR 613C); and**

**WHEREAS, Atlantic County is requesting that the Eleventh Avenue, Mill & Overlay Resurfacing project be deleted from FY 2017 of the FY 2016-2025 TIP/STIP; and**

**WHEREAS, Atlantic County is requesting that the Washington Avenue, Mill & Overlay Resurfacing project be added to the FY 2016-2025 TIP/STIP in FY 2017; and**

**WHEREAS, the construction cost for these projects are both \$1,700,000, thus maintaining fiscal constraint; and**


**WHEREAS, this change of projects will not have a negative impact on the air quality in the region; and**

**WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT), New Jersey Transit, and SJTPO have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Procedures to Amend and Modify the SJTPO TIP and the State TIP; and**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Policy Board of the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization hereby amends the FY 2016-2025 Transportation Improvement Program to delete a project in FY 2017 and replace it with a new project.**
