ITEM 2007-18: Approving the Selection of Brown & Connery, LLP for SJTPO General Legal Counsel

PROPOSAL

At its meeting on March 4, 2020, the Consultant Selection Committee consisting of SJTPO and SJTA staff unanimously recommended the firm of Brown & Connery, LLP, as SJTPO General Legal Counsel. BACKGROUND

The Notice of Availability of Requests was advertised in The Press of Atlantic City, The Daily Journal, The South Jersey Times.

Three (3) proposals were received and reviewed by the Consultant Selection Committee with Brown & Connery, LLP emerging as the top ranked firm for SJTPO General Legal Counsel.

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES
